THE OHIO WATERCOLOR SOCIETY 45th ANNUAL EXHIBITION
WATERCOLOR OHIO 2022

Watercolor Ohio 2022, the 45th Annual Juried Ohio Watercolor Society Exhibition, will be on display at the Ohio Arts Council's Riffe Gallery in Columbus, Ohio.

The exhibition will open on July 30, 2022 and runs through October 7, 2022. An opening reception by the Ohio Watercolor Society will be held on July 30 starting at 1 p.m.

Sponsored by the Ohio Watercolor Society, a non-profit fine arts organization, this highly competitive juried show annually attracts entries from the entire state of Ohio and areas along its boundaries. Chosen for the exhibition were 60 paintings from 244 entries submitted by 150 artists.

A nationally recognized juror from outside Ohio juries the show. This year's juror of selection and awards was Pat Moseuk of Concord, California. Moseuk classifies herself as a "Contemporary Urban Abstract Painter." Her work is captivated with texture, line, color, design and shape that are the aesthetics of the urban environment. She first studied at the California College of Arts and Crafts in Oakland and then transferred to San Francisco's Academy of Art University, receiving a B.F.A in Illustration with distinction. She is a signature member of several watermedia societies including the National Watercolor Society, International Society of Acrylic Painters and California Watercolor Association.

An exhibition of 32 works including all of the award winners will tour the state of Ohio following the conclusion of the full exhibition at the Mansfield Art Center. More than 300 Ohio artists are signature or associate members of the Ohio Watercolor Society, which was established in 1978 to further the stature of aqueous painting as a major art medium and to assist in the education of Ohio artists and the general public.
